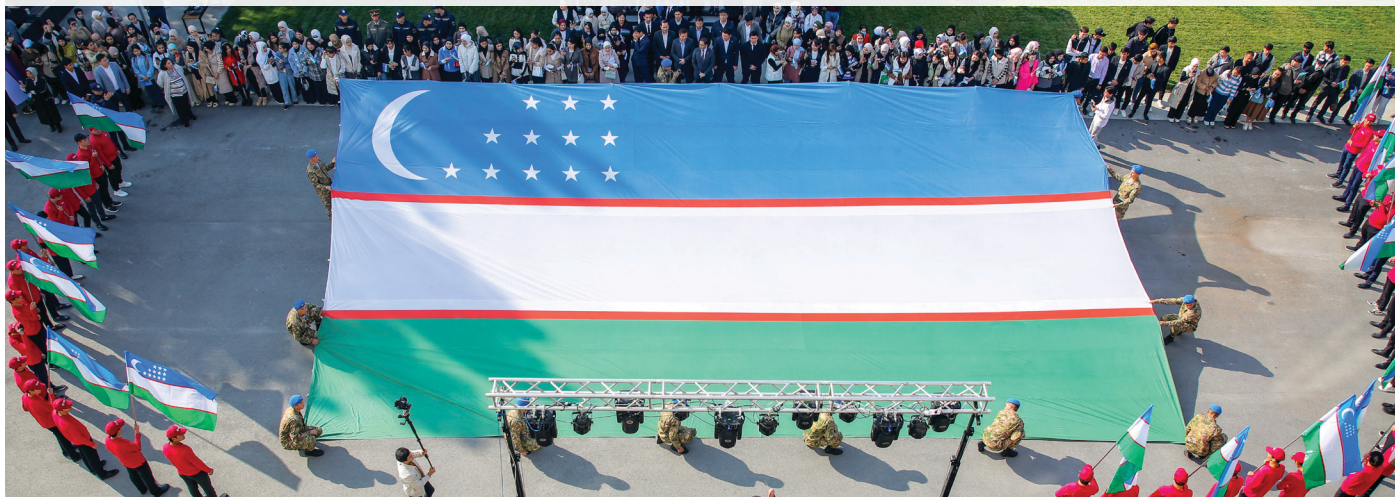

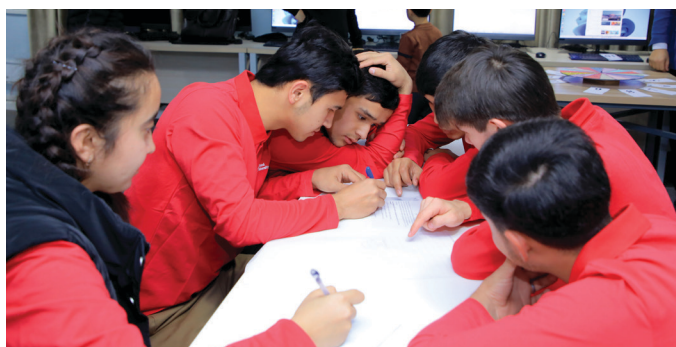

Additionally, the seminar included discussions on the content and essence of the credit-module system and the methods and tools for independent learning.



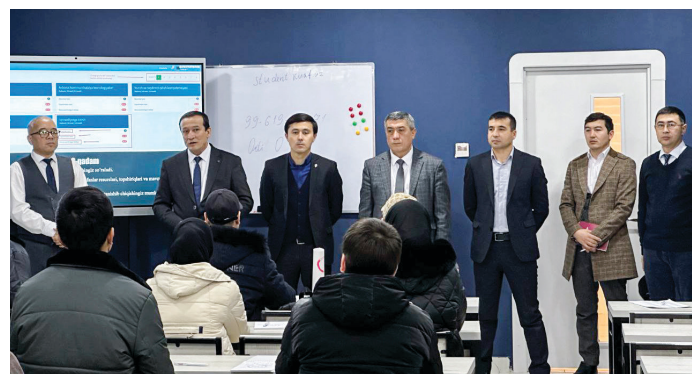
The rector of the Kokand University Andijan Branch (KUAF) met with students and their parents
